RESOLUTION ADVOCATING FOR THE IMMEDIATE ROLLBACK ON THE PRICE OF GASOLINE, DIESEL, KEROSENE LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) AND ALL PRIME COMMODITIES THAT AFFECT AND HAMPER THE DAILY OPERATION OF OUR SMALL FARMERS AND FISHERFOLK IN THE PROVINCE OF TAWI-TAWI.

WHEREAS, the result of the price monitoring activity recently conducted by the Agriculture and Fishery Council (AFC) of Tawi-Tawi on the prices of prime commodities particularly gasoline and diesel revealed that the expected price rollback imposed by the national government has not been properly observed by the business sectors in the Province of Tawi-Tawi;

WHEREAS, the higher prices of prime commodities have greatly affected the living condition of our operation in bringing their agricultural fishery product to the market;

WHEREAS, price monitoring of prime commodities in the Province of Tawi-Tawi must be given full attention and serious concern with synergic effort by Provincial Government, concerned line agencies, LGUs, POs, the local media and all AFC stakeholders to assure the public that price stability are properly observed in order to achieve sound economic activities as our immediate measures to combat the effects of global financial crises;

WHEREAS, there is a felt-need to urge the business sector and local businessmen to effect the rollback of prices on prime commodities sold in the Province of Tawi-Tawi, so as not to extensively hamper the mandate and goal of the government of improving the incomes of small farmers, fisherfolk and the rural poor in the countryside;


NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly assembled, be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request Provincial Government of Tawi-Tawi, eleven (11) Municipalities, DTI, the local Media and other concerned agencies including the stakeholders to act promptly and collectively in advocating for the immediate rollback in the prices of prime commodities sold throughout the province.




