RESOLUTION STRONGLY ENDORSING TO HONORABLE ROBERTO M. PAGDANGANAN, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM (DAR), METRO MANILA THE HEREIN PROJECT PROPOSAL OF BONGAO WATER DISTRICT (BWD) ON WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT AND EXPANSION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETEEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php19.9M) TO BE TAKEN OUT OF THIRTY SIX BILLION PESOS (Php 36B) ILL-GOTTEN MARCOS' WEALTH FORGED UNDER CARP

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, as the legislative body of the province, shall enact ordinances, approved resolutions which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17, Section 468 (4)(ii) of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, water supply in Bongao, Tawi-Tawi has always been inadequate since Marcos time and yet it is the capital town and center of commerce and other business activities in the Province of Tawi-Tawi;

WHEREAS, the problem of water supply is acute and Bongao Water District (BWD) is only serving about 32% of the entire Bongao population and most affected are those living in the hinterland of Sanga-Sanga, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi who are mostly marginalized farmers and fisher folks and other innocent civilians and MNLF non-combatant who were victims of war and atrocities during the advent of Marcos martial law;

WHEREAS, peace and development efforts including business investments and farms and fishing production has been hampered by the lack of accessible water supply in these areas;

WHEREAS, the proposed BWD project will provide potable water accessibility to all the farmers and fisher folks who lived nearby along Sanga-Sanga road toward the hinterland and further promote agricultural production and other economic livelihood activities in the area;


WHEREAS, in order for Bongao to be at par with the progress of capital towns of other provinces in the autonomous region, it is necessary that Bongao should be given the right form of basic services specially water.

NOW THEREFORE


Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that this vital resolution should be forwarded to Honorable ROBERTO M. PAGDANGANAN, Secretary of the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) strongly endorsing for his approval for the financial allocation of the proposed BWD Water System Expansion Program in the amount of nineteen million nine hundred thousand pesos (Php19.9M) to be funded out of thirty six billion pesos (Php36B) ill-gotten wealth of Marcoses awarded by the Supreme Court for Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program (CARP).
