A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROVINCIAL LEGAL OFFICER ATTY ALNIE A. BURAHIM TO ENGAGE IN PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW

SPONSORED BY: Hon. ABDULWAHAB M. TAMBURANI

**WHEREAS**, the Province of Tawi-Tawi is composed of 11 island municipalities with a roughly estimated total number of population of 366,550;

**WHEREAS**, in the entire Province of Tawi-Tawi, there are only three (3) practicing lawyers and that include **ATTY. ALNIE A. BURAHIM** who is presently serving as the Provincial Legal Officer of the Provincial Government of Tawi-Tawi;

**WHEREAS**, with the hundreds of thousand number of population vis-à-vis the scant number of practicing lawyers in the entire province, it is but sound and for the benefits of Tawi-Tawians needing legal services to allow the Provincial Legal Officer to engage in the private practice of law provided it shall not be in conflict with his powers, duties and responsibilities defined and provided for by the Local Government Code of 1991, thus, always giving priority to the interest of the Province.

**NOW THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FORGOING PREMISES**, at a session duly called and assembled, all the duly elected and qualified members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after due discussions and deliberations, and upon motion of **HON. ABDULWAHAB M. TAMBURANI** duly seconded by **HON. NASSER HABE**, have hereby approved and confirmed the forgoing resolution authorizing **ATTY. ALNIE A. BURAHIM**, Provincial Legal Officer, to engage in the private practice of law provided it shall not be in conflict with his powers, duties and responsibilities defined and provided for by the Local Government Code of 1991, thus, always giving priority to the interest of the province.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the Province hereby approves, confirms and ratifies the foregoing Resolution as well as such agreements and acts desirable pursuant to and in furtherance of giving authority to the Provincial Legal Officer to engage in private practice of his legal profession.
